

Due to the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR, Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016), please, be advised that we process your personal data.

Thus, the controller of those personal data as soon as they are collected is Asseco Business Solutions SA, ul. Konrada Wallenroda 4C, 20-607 Lublin (Poland), KRS 28257.

We process or will process your personal data for the following purposes:

- contacting you as the performance of contracts you are not a party to, and in relation to which we have obtained your personal data,
- performing direct marketing of our own products and services, including—if you expressly separately agree—sending commercial information by electronic means (such as invitations to events organized by us or information about our products and services),
- establishing, investigating or defending claims,
- controlling and improving quality of the services rendered,

i.e. upon the legal basis of Art. 6.1.f. GDPR, that are our legitimate interests, yet in such a situation you have the right to object to processing of your personal data effective from the moment you make it as far as the marketing purposes concern, and for the rest of cases – effective unless we demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of yours or for the establishment, exercise or defense of our legal claims,

or

- to comply with the legal obligation, including billing purposes, tax purposes and in connection with bookkeeping regulations, i.e. upon the legal basis of Art. 6.1.c. GDPR,

or

- executing contracts which you are or may be a party to, or to take action on your request before concluding such a contract, including providing services to you, maintaining an account in one of our services, handling complaints, i.e. upon the legal basis of Art. 6.1.b. GDPR,

We intend to store your data for the above purposes for no longer than it is necessary to achieve the above objectives as follows:

- in connection with the execution of a contract, for which you are a party of, for the duration of this contract,
- for the purposes of direct marketing of our products and services, based on our legitimate interest, until the date of your objection to processing personal data.

After the periods mentioned above, the data will be stored for purposes, to the extent, and as long as it is required by law or to establish, investigate or defend claims.

You have the right to request from us, at any time, the access to your personal data, their transfer, rectification, deletion or restriction of processing.

You also have the right to object to processing of your personal data. Because of such an objection, we will no longer be able to process your personal data unless we demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of yours or for the establishment, exercise or defence of our legal claims.

You have the right to file a complaint, in connection with the processing of your personal data, to the supervisory body, which is Prezes Urzędu Ochrony Danych Osobowych (The President of Personal Data Protection Office).

In case of obtaining your personal data from you, their application may be required to conclude and implement the contract concluded with you. Failure to provide your personal data will prevent us from concluding or executing the contract. In some cases, the law may impose upon us the obligation to obtain your personal data, e.g. for tax or billing purposes. In other cases, providing your personal data is voluntary, but failure to do so may make it impossible to implement some or all the above-mentioned purposes (e.g. we will not be able to send you our commercial information).

In connection with the implementation of the above-mentioned purposes, we process or would process the following categories of personal data:

your name and surname along with any of the following categories: e-mail address, telephone number, geographical address, and – if we conclude a contract – also a national identification number

– in any case of processing limited only those that are necessary to achieve a given purpose.

We have obtained your personal data directly from you (e.g. via an internet form), through another entity with whom we cooperate or from widely available sources (e.g. commercial registers).

The collected personal data can be made available to our business partners, contractors and other entities acting on our behalf, as well as to banks, bodies competent for public health services, debt collectors—always to the extent appropriate for processing, execution of the contract to which you are a party, or according to which we provide you services.

In case of potential transferring your personal data to third countries, i.e. countries outside the European Economic Area, we will transfer your data only to countries for which the European Commission adopted a decision finding an appropriate level of protection or based on standard clauses adopted by European Commission.

Under no circumstances will we use your data for automated decision making.
